Bream Creek Farmers Market runs on the first Sunday of every month from December 2nd 2012 from 9am - 1pm.

Barrow or Basket

Bring a wheelbarrow or basket full and share a community space \$ 5 (first market free)

Conditions:

- An itemised inventory of goods provided and their prices must be provided for the Community Stall leader either on or before market day (INVENTORY FORM PROVIDED)
- All goods must be grown/produced in a local backyard/kitchen and be in line with the ethos of the Bream Creek Farmers Market ie as fresh as possible (SEE WEBSITE FOR MORE DETAILS)
- Food produce and products must be handled and prepared in line with all relevant food safety guidelines (SEE FINE PRINT AND LINKS FOR MORE DETAILS)
- Goods must be priced and packaged, ready to exchange with the buyer (SEE FINE PRINT FOR MORE DETAILS)
- Revenue must be either collected at 1:30pm or by an alternative arrangement made prior to the market at the discretion of the Community Stall Leader
- Community contributors may select to
 - a) allow afternoon pricing changes at the discretion of the Community Stall leader (i.e. discounted produce, priced to move at up to 75% off)
 - b) allow produce remaining at the closure of the market (1pm) be donated to the BCFM Food Bank (more information coming soon)
 - c) collect unsold goods in person between 1pm and 1:30pm
 - d) collect unsold goods by prior arrangement with the Community Stall Leader
